


How to get the tworidge e-book for free, 11-14 December 2020

For legal reasons, Amazon has a number of national shops, rather than just one international shop. This is a bit confusing for people outside the US and for people not owning a separate Kindle Reader device; hence these instructions.

Option 1: Go to www.tworidge.org. Click the BUY button in the image to the right. Go directly to step 7. If you are not a member of Amazon, you'll need to sign up using your name and email address (that is all).



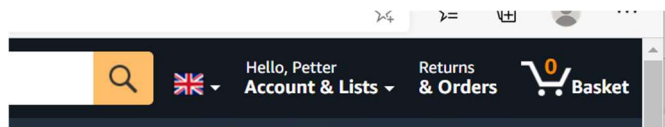

Option 2: If for some reason the above didn't work, follow the steps below.

1. Go to www.amazon.com. That is, NOT amazon.se, amazon.co.uk etc.
2. To be able to shop, you will need to create an account on Amazon if you don't have one. They will ask for a valid email address and a password of at least six characters.

3. Hopefully, you are already at the US version of Amazon. If not, like in the image below where the UK flag is shown, change country for where you want to shop, to United States. (Click on the flag icon, then select Change country/region at the bottom of the list to change the country.)

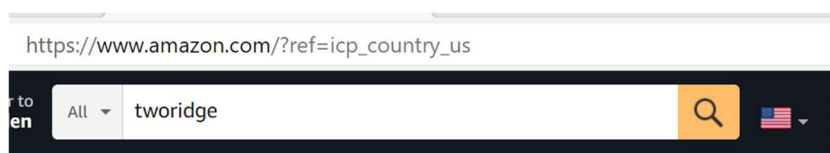

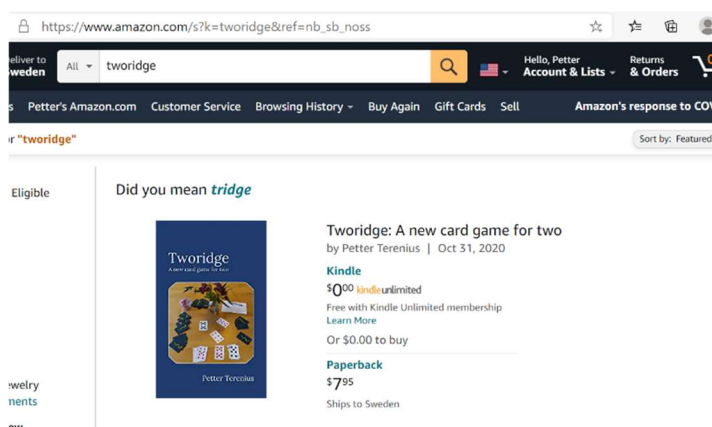

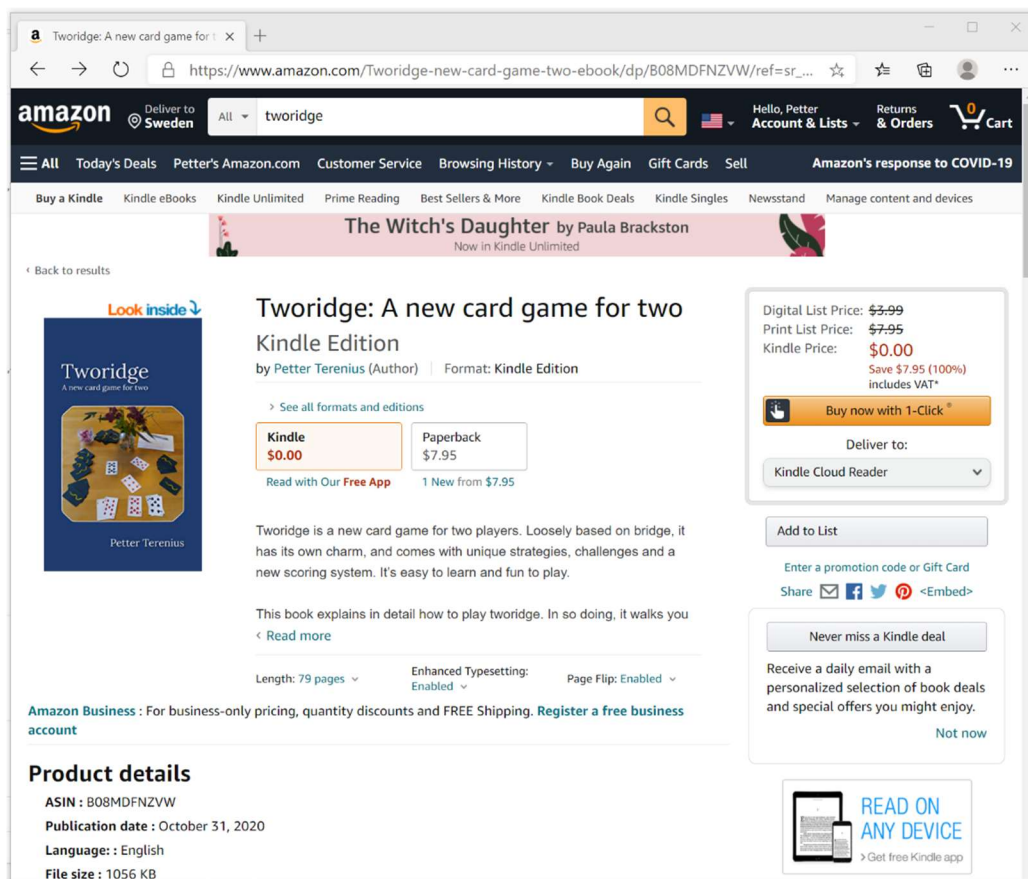
4. Search for Tworidge. (Note the American flag to the right of the search field.)



5. Click on the book image to get to the product page.



6. Check that the price says \$0.00, and choose “Buy now with 1-Click”. You should now be able to view the e-book in your browser/phone/iPad etc (in what Amazon calls the Kindle Cloud Reader, a special software running in your browser or as an app on your phone).

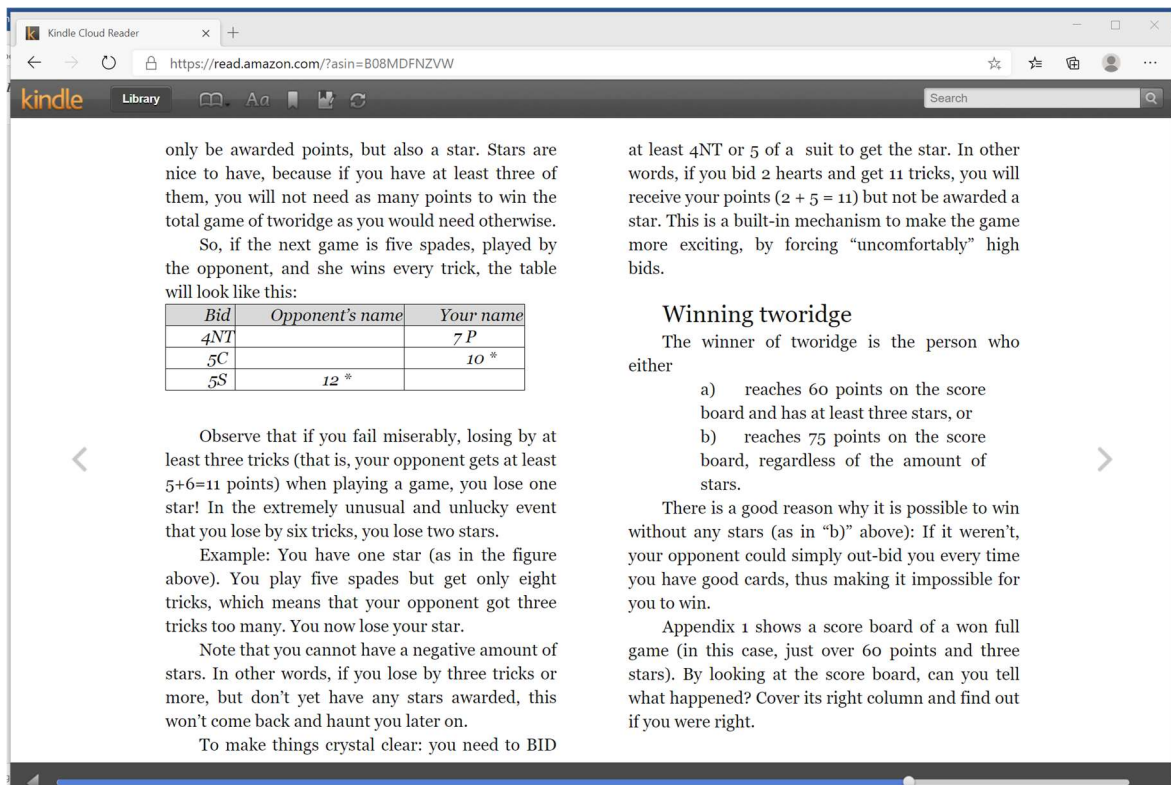


7. You should now see the book in your browser, as shown on next page. This is the Kindle Cloud Reader.

The book has been added to your Kindle library, so you should be able to read it at any time. Note that you can increase the font size, create bookmarks, search etc from the top row (the dark row where it says kindle).

The easiest way to return to the book is to reopen the Kindle Cloud Reader, found at <https://read.amazon.com/>. It's available from both your computer and your phone, but obviously it is easier to read a book on a computer screen than on a phone. Whenever you access this link, it will open with the book you're just reading. Click “Library” to return to your personal bookshelf.

It's also possible to download any of your e-books to your computer. Easiest is to follow instructions such as the ones found here. <https://www.businessinsider.com/how-to-read-kindle-books-on-pc>



You can also order the book printed, as a pocket book. If you are in the UK, it should still be delivered for Christmas (I'm writing this 11 December), but not if you are in Sweden. If you live in Europe, it's probably wise to order a printed book from amazon.co.uk rather than from amazon.com.
